The MEC highly appreciate the announcement by the Auditor General that Limpopo has seen the greatest improvements in Municipal audit performance in the year under review and receives with humility the commend of the Auditor General on the coordinated effort that was made by Provincial Treasury working together with Provincial Coghsta on these improvements as well as ensuring that as a province we live up to the promise made five (05) years ago by the Honourable Premier, Ntate Chupu Mathabatha, that Limpopo will never again be the skunk of the country when it comes to prudent fiscal management and accountability.
