MEC Seaparo Sekaoti continues to maintain a personal conviction that corruption eats into the moral fibre of our nation and undermines public confidence in the governing systems, as such, he will avail himself and the resources of the Office he leads to support all initiatives announced by the President and the work of the law enforcement agencies in the investigation of all wrong doings in the utilisation of state resources, particularly the COVID-19 targeted funding.
