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

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## **1. INTRODUCTION**

The purpose of this report is to provide an overview of the state of finances to:

- Identify risk areas in municipal finances to implement proper responses to the identified risks;
- Identify municipalities in financial distress to determine the extent of the financial problems and to establish what support is required by the municipality and if an intervention is required per legislation; and
- Assessing the budget performance of municipalities assists in serving as a control and management tool and as an early warning signal for the identification of financial problems.

This report uses actual information from the latest information from the municipal In-Year financial monitoring system (i.e. section 71 reports).

## **2. BACKGROUND**

In terms of section 71(6) of the Municipal Finance Management Act (Act 56 of 2003) (MFMA), the Provincial Treasury must, within 22 days after the end of each month submit to National Treasury a consolidated statement on the state of the municipalities' budgets per municipality and per municipal entity. Furthermore, section 71(7) requires that, Provincial Treasury must, within 30 days after the end of each quarter, make public as may be prescribed, a consolidated statement in the prescribed format on the state of municipalities' budgets per municipality and per municipal entity. The MEC for Finance must submit such consolidated statement to the provincial legislature no later than 45 days after the end of each quarter.

## **3. METHODOLOGY AND APPROACH**

The methodology and approach used for the compilation of this report included the following:

- The data for the analysis used in this report was extracted from the National Treasury Local Government Database. (Section 71(1) requires the Municipal Accounting Officer "by no later than 10 working days after the end of each month submit to the Mayor of the municipality and the relevant provincial treasury a statement of the municipalities budget performance in a prescribe format..."
- A comparison was made between the information submitted to the National Treasury Local Government database and the Schedule C schedule submitted to the Provincial Treasury
- Provincial Treasury is concerned about the reliability of budget and expenditure figures submitted by municipalities. It was noted in the past that there has been discrepancies in the data submitted to the Local Government Database by municipalities. To ensure that the figures published by Provincial Treasury are reliable, it is imperative that each municipality scrutinize, verify and sign-off the Appendix B schedules sent to National Treasury.

## 4. PROVINCIAL OVERVIEW


- The province raised 88 percent of budgeted revenue for the quarter.
- Mopani has the lowest average of revenue billed due to Mopani District municipality reporting a revenue of 640 778 percent against the quarter target.
- Mogalakwena municipality reported an excess of 101 percent revenue against its target for the quarter whilst Lephalale did not report any revenue billed/raised for the quarter.
- Actual expenditure reported is on average 55 percent less than the actual revenue reported for the quarter.




### Breakdown of Revenue by District per Source - September 2016




### Breakdown of Expenditure by District per Source - September 2016





- National Grants constitute 82 percent for capital expenditure funding.
- Only municipalities in Capricorn District municipalities managed to report consistently between the source of funding and the capital expenditure.
- Variances identified are due to differences on the budgeted figures for the quarter
- 49 percent of the capital budget was spent on water and sanitation project and 35 percent was spent on roads and storm water drainage.
- Capricorn, Sekhukhune and Vhembe average spending is below 50 percent due to extremely low spending in Molomole, Fetakgomo-Greater Tubatse, Makhalo-Thulamela, Musina, Thabazimbi and Waterberg whose spending is below 20 percent.




### Capital Sources of Finance - September 2016

- Capricorn and Vhembe district municipalities have on average spent more on the operational budget compared to Mopani and Waterberg district municipalities spending more on the capital budget.
- Sekhukhune district municipalities have spent on both operational and capital expenditure.




- The total payments in the province is R 7,064 million against the total receipts of R 7,176 million in the cash flow statements.

- Other expenditure of R3,3 million is the highest expenditure item in the province.
- Employees related cost and councilors remuneration for the quarter constitute 36 percent of the actual expenditure incurred for the quarter.


### Cash Receipts per district by Source- September 2016




### Cash Payments per District by Item - September 2016





- 84 percent of debtors are 90 days and above overdue. The biggest contributor to this is debtors owed by households.
- Other debtors includes farms and these debtors together with the business constitute 38 percent of the outstanding debtors.
- Currently there is a processes to resolve debt that are being owed by government debtors whose contribution to municipal debtors is 16 percent.
- The biggest amount on debtors is water services which constitute 42 percent of the debtors, property rates is 24 percent, electricity at 21 percent and other at 13 percent.


### Debtors by Customer Group - September 2016




### Debtors Age Analysis - September 2016





### Creditors Age Analysis - September 2016




### Creditors Age Analysis - September 2016

■ 0 - 30 Days   ■ 31 - 60 Days   ■ 61 - 90 Days   ■ Over 90 Days




### Creditors by Customer Group- September 2016


