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## 1. INTRODUCTION

The purpose of this report is to provide an overview of the state of finances to:

- Identify risk areas in municipal finances to implement proper responses to the identified risks;
- Identify municipalities in financial distress to determine the extent of the financial problems and to establish what support is required by the municipality and if an intervention is required per legislation; and
- Assessing the budget performance of municipalities assists in serving as a control and management tool and as an early warning signal for the identification of financial problems.

This report uses actual information from the latest information from the municipal In-Year financial monitoring system (i.e. section 71 reports).

## 2. BACKGROUND

In terms of section 71(6) of the Municipal Finance Management Act (Act 56 of 2003) (MFMA), the Provincial Treasury must, within 22 days after the end of each month submit to National Treasury a consolidated statement on the state of the municipalities' budgets per municipality and per municipal entity. Furthermore, section 71(7) requires that, Provincial Treasury must, within 30 days after the end of each quarter, make public as may be prescribed, a consolidated statement in the prescribed format on the state of municipalities' budgets per municipality and per municipal entity. The MEC for Finance must submit such consolidated statement to the provincial legislature no later than 45 days after the end of each quarter.

## 3. METHODOLOGY AND APPROACH

The methodology and approach used for the compilation of this report included the following:

- The data for the analysis used in this report was extracted from the National Treasury Local Government Database. (Section 71(1) requires the Municipal Accounting Officer *"by no later than 10 working days after the end of each month submit to the Mayor of the municipality and the relevant provincial treasury a statement of the municipalities budget performance in a prescribe format..."*)
- A comparison was made between the information submitted to the National Treasury Local Government database and the Schedule C schedule submitted to the Provincial Treasury
- Provincial Treasury is concerned about the reliability of budget and expenditure figures submitted by municipalities. It was noted in the past that there has been discrepancies in the data submitted to the Local Government Database by municipalities. To ensure that the figures published by Provincial Treasury are reliable, it is imperative that each municipality scrutinize, verify and sign-off the Appendix B schedules sent to National Treasury.





- National government grants constitute 60 percent of the total operational revenue raised
- Operational revenue budget was adjusted downwards by 9 percent.
- Employee related costs plus councilors remunerations are the highest contribute at 73 percentage.


### Breakdown of Revenue by District per Source - March 2016




### Breakdown of Expenditure by District per Source - March 2016





### Breakdown of Capital Sources by District per Source - March 2016




### Breakdown of Capital Expenditure by District per Source March 2016








### Capital Expenditure Per Item - March 2016

- The percentage operational budget The Capricorn has exceeded their operational spending which is mainly caused by employee related costs and remuneration of councilors.
- The operational spending in the province is fairly good; which is indicated by the operational spent over 60 per cent.
- The Sekhukhune District has the lowest capital spent at 33 per cent
- Mopani district Municipalities have spent more than 100% of the YTD capital expenditure budget.





- Property rates constitute 3 per cent on the total receipts; with the Vhembe District as the lowest collector of Property rates.
- Other receipts constitutes 2 per cent of the total receipts in the province with no other incomes from the Vhembe District
- Other payments constitute 45 per cent of the total payments in the province.


### Cash Receipts per district by Source- March 2016




### Cash Payments per District by item-March 2016





- Households are the major contributor of outstanding debtors at 42 percent, followed by other debtors at 36 percent


### Debtors by Customer Group - March 2016




### Debtors Age Analysis per District - March 2016






### Creditors Age Analysis - March 2016




### Creditors by Customer Group - March 2016
